Subject: Art

Each class should have an art display board either inside or outside of their classroom. 'Tate Edward' is the title given to the art displays around the school – a play on words of the Tate gallery and our school saint name. The display should show the progression of the unit of work as well as displaying the following features:

- Skills footprints alongside examples of children's work.
- The art curriculum token.
- The name/photo of the artist who is being studied in the unit (frame)
- A 'what have we learnt about this person and their work so far...' section (frame)
